10. Use the [Travel Guide](#) to help plan your Pavilion-hopping schedule. Cluster your Pavilion visits based on proximity so you can save time and visit multiple Pavilions in one night!

8. Tickets for children 12 and under are free when booked with an adult ticket. Even though they are free, tickets must be booked online to secure entrance into a Pavilion.
